BARRY MICHAEL FISHER IS THE 2009 WINNER OF THE R.V.A. JONES AWARD.

Mr. Fisher is Vice President, General Counsel and Corporate Secretary of SAP Canada Inc. In addition to responsibility for the Legal and Contracts Departments at SAP Canada, Mr. Fisher is the Chief Compliance Officer, the Chief Privacy Officer, a member of the Executive Leadership Team, and is the SAP Canada representative on the SAP Global Security Initiative. Following his call to the Bar in Ontario and a judicial clerkship, Mr. Fisher began his career practicing corporate securities and international law with a large law firm in the United States Midwest. He returned to Canada and practiced Canadian law with major law firms, and as a Foreign Legal Consultant opened the Toronto office of his U.S. law firm. Prior to joining SAP, Mr. Fisher was the General Counsel to a group of inter-listed mining companies. He holds undergraduate degrees in Economics and Philosophy, a Masters Degree in Philosophy, and a law degree from the University of Western Ontario where he was Editor-in-Chief of the Law Review. As well, he earned an LL.M. while in the United States. Mr. Fisher has held various executive positions within the International, Information Technology and Corporate Counsel Sections of the Canadian Bar Association, and was the founding Chair of the Committee on Canadian Law of the Section of International Law and Practice of the American Bar Association, and served on the Section's Governing Council.

Mr. Fisher sat on the Board of Directors and Executive Committee of the Canadian Corporate Counsel Association, chairing its Membership Committee. He was a well-respected member of the CCCA Board who served with passionate interest and whose perspective in board and executive discussions helped to frame the policies and issues that define CCCA as it exists today.

Among Mr. Fisher's numerous contributions to CCCA and corporate counsel, we highlight the following:

- The Davies Ward Phillips Vineberg LLP/CCCA In-House Counsel Barometer Survey which he initiated five years ago and continues to advise on every year.
