1. Increasing the Bottom Line: How to Maximize Recoveries from Insurers in Tough Economic Times

Disasters. Class actions. Product liability claims. All of these divert money, time, and effort from the corporation's true goals of carrying on business effectively. This portion of the seminar explains how to deal with and manage insurance claims to pay for large losses, and how to maximize recovery from your insurers, with real-world examples and practical advice.

2. Are You Aware of Changes to Your CGL Insurance Policy?

The CGL is the standard liability insurance policy issued to all Canadian businesses. The "standard" CGL has been amended to drastically reduce coverage for certain bodily injury and property damage claims. Some insurers are using this newer (and narrower) policy form, and some are using the older (and broader form). You need to be aware of which policy your corporation has and the differences in coverage, as there may be significantly reduced coverage for product liability and other claims against your corporation under the new policy.

3. Protecting the Directors and Officers from Rescission of the Policy

An insurer is entitled to rescind (or void) an insurance policy when there has been a material misrepresentation or non-disclosure when applying for insurance. Needless to say, management of your corporation will not be happy when they find out their insurer has rescinded the D&O policy. Management will look to corporate counsel to explain how and why this occurred. This portion of the seminar will explain the law of misrepresentation, non-disclosure, and rescission in the context of D&O policies, and also will cover what to do to protect both the corporation and its directors and officers when applying for a D&O policy. The panel will also discuss a number of optional policy provisions that are available to protect directors and officers from rescission.
